Choose the ticket that suits your week, then stack up the savings. Camp runs 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.

Refer a family and you each get £10 credit. Five referrals earns a free day.

HAF-funded places are available at selected locations for eligible families. Prices vary by location and season, so please confirm current rates when you book.

your questions, answered

Can I book individual days?

Yes. Book a single day, a few days or the whole week. Book 5 or more sessions and £20 comes off.

What should my child bring?

A nut-free packed lunch, a water bottle, weather-suitable clothes, trainers and a swim kit. Please label everything.

Who will look after my child?

Qualified teachers, coaches and childcare professionals, all enhanced-DBS checked and safeguarding trained.

What are your staff ratios?

1:6 for our youngest and 1:14 for older children, smaller than Ofsted recommends.

Is HAF funding available?

Yes. HAF-funded places are offered at selected locations for eligible families. Get in touch and we'll help you book.

What if my childcare needs change?

No problem. Our bookings are flexible and we're happy to transfer your dates whenever your plans change.

Can I reach camp during the day?

Yes. A dedicated camp phone and WhatsApp, answered by your Camp Leader.

How does collection work?

Children are released only to adults you authorise, using a collection password.
